

Reservation Policy at Arty Lee Campground

Please follow all the rules and regulations of the campground listed below based on the Russell County Park Ordinance.

1. ONLY two vehicles per campsite. All camping units, equipment, and vehicles shall be placed within the perimeter of the designated campsite without infringing on adjoining campsites or vegetation. Where high-impact areas have been designated, all camping units, equipment, and vehicles shall be placed within the defined borders of the high-impact area.
2. Vehicles must not block the gate entrance, fire exit, ATV trail, or park in the reserved campsite. If vehicles are parked in non-designated parking areas may be towed at the owner's expense.
3. Display the camping receipt where it can be easily viewed, such as the window of the camper or car window.
4. Pets must always be on a leash that does not exceed six feet in length. All waste from pets must be disposed of properly.
5. Do not walk or take pets on ATV-designated trails.
6. Maximum of 6 adults per campsite, Kids are free.
7. Smoking is ONLY permitted in designated areas of the campground.
8. No littering, please keep campsites tidy.
9. No unattended fires and campfires are only allowed in approved fire rings or designated areas.
10. No glass containers are allowed in the campground.
11. Possession of fireworks, firearms, crossbows, air guns, bow & arrow, or weapons is prohibited.
12. Please do not feed wild animals, and keep all food and scraps contained.
13. Trash dumpster only for registered guests.
14. All campers and individuals must be registered guests listed on the permit.
15. No camping shall be permitted for more than 14 nights within 30 days.
16. Any personal property left at the campsite after the reservation period check-out time shall be removed by park staff at the owner's expense.
17. Damage to any campground or campsite, not considered normal wear and tear, may be charged to the person registering for the campground or campsite on an itemized cost basis by the reservation acknowledgment or reservation confirmation.
18. Any use of ATV Spearhead Trails MUST provide proof of trail pass (season/day-use).

Russell County Cancellation Policy as based on the Russell County Park Ordinance, please obey this policy.

There is a minimum \$25 cancellation fee for all reservations.

We do so as a courtesy to our guests without incurring any additional fees, because we do understand circumstances happen.

NO REFUNDS OR CANCELLATIONS less than two weeks before your stay. If you book a campsite at least a month in advance you may cancel or change your reservation when given two weeks' notice.
